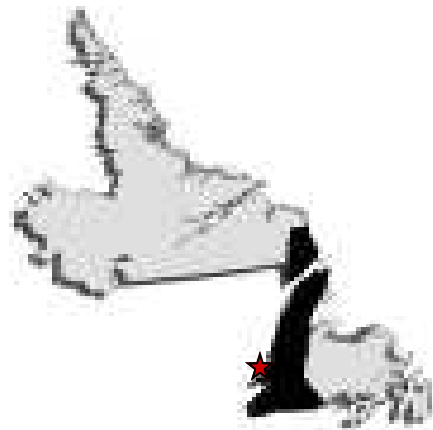

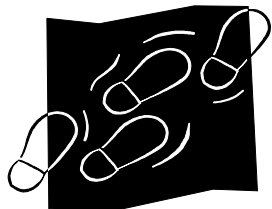


## Pathfinder Learning Centre

## Enrollment Process

Admission to the PLC is on an individual basis. Acceptance is not automatic. Students must be able to work independently.

You may be referred by your school, another agency or self-referred. All perspective students must complete three things in order for their file to be processed: complete application, provide a current transcript, and write CAAT test at the College of the North Atlantic and have it forwarded onto the PLC. Once all this information is gathered, the applicant is contacted and an interview may be scheduled. Acceptance to the PLC is based on the recommendations of the Admissions Committee after the interview process.
