Haunted House

Please use caution when dropping off and picking up your child as there will be a significant amount of traffic around the school.

Halloween Activities

Teachers will be integrating the Halloween theme into their classroom activities on Monday. Students are permitted to wear or bring costumes. However, please use caution with your child's costume. Long costumes are a safety concern. As well, students will be permitted to wear masks at appropriate times in school. Masks should not be worn on the way to or from school. We remind students and parents that scented products are not to be worn to school, even as part of a costume.

We encourage you to provide your children with healthy nutritious snacks. Please remember our allergy alerts when sending treats with your children. As well, there are students in our school with diabetic concerns and therefore cannot consume many common treats. You might also consider providing non-food treats. Some suggestions include Halloween themed pencils, notepads, stickers, erasers, costume jewelry, small toys/games, bookmarks, books, etc..
